"WASHINGTON POST" ACCUSATIONS AGAINST WALDHEIM

LEADING AUSTRIAN PAPERS - WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE MASS-CIRCULATION TABLOID "KRONENZEITUNG" - TODAY CITE A "WASHINGTON POST" REPORT CLAIMING THAT BETWEEN 1946 AND 1947 SOVIET AND YUGOSLAV INTELLIGENCE TRIED TO RECRUIT WALDHEIM AS A COMMUNIST AGENT, THREATENING HIM WITH WAR CRIMES. DENIED THE STORY, ACCORDING TO AUSTRIAN RADIO. WALDHEIM SPOKESMAN GEROLD CHRISTIAN REPORTEDLY HAS TOLD THE "POST" THAT, "CONTRARY TO EARLIER STATEMENTS BY WALDHEIM, RECENT FINDINGS SHOW WALDHEIM WAS STATIONED IN THE KOZARA REGION IN YUGOSLAVIA IN 1942". CHRISTIAN, SPEAKING ON NATIONAL RADIO LAST NIGHT, SAID HE HAD BEEN MISQUOTED BY THE "POST". HE EMPHASIZED THAT WALDHEIM HAD ALREADY CONFIRMED IN AN APRIL 1 INTERVIEW THAT HE HAD BEEN IN THIS AREA IN HIS CAPACITY AS A SUPPLY OFFICER. THE PRESIDENT'S OFFICE HAS DISMISSED THE ENTIRE "POST" REPORT AS "RIDICULOUS". CHRISTIAN SAID THAT THE CHARGES ALLEGING THAT WALDHEIM HAD BEEN INVOLVED IN WAR CRIMES IN THE BALKANS WERE "OLD ACCUSATIONS DEVOID OF ALL FOUNDATIONS WHICH HAD ALREADY BEEN REFUTED SEVERAL TIMES IN THE PAST". --- IN ITS REGULAR EVENING NEWS ROUND-UP ON OCTOBER 30. AUSTRIAN TV'S WASHINGTON CORRESPONDENT NOTED THAT THE ISSUE IS "AGAIN BEING WIDELY COVERED BY THE U.S. MEDIA. ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWARD MEESE IS QUOTED AS SAYING "THERE IS NO HURRY IN THIS MATTER SINCE IT DESERVES CLOSE SCRUTINY, CONSIDERING THAT IT INVOLVES A CURRENT HEAD OF STATE AND A FORMER UN SECRETARY-GENERAL". THE MASS DAILY "KURIÈR" IS THE ONLY AUSTRIAN PAPER TO COMMENT ON THE NEW ALLEGATIONS. EDITOR-IN-CHIEF HANS RAUSCHER CHARGES THAT WALDHEIM IS AGAIN AT THE CENTER OF "DEFAMATORY REPORTS BY OTHERWISE PRESTIGEOUS U.S. PAPERS". "WALDHEIM HIMSELF, HOWEVER, IS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR SOME OF THE CONFUSION SURROUNDING HIS WARTIME ACTIVITIES", SAYS RAUSCHER. HE ALSO NOTES THAT THE TIMING OF THE ACCUSATIONS COINCIDES WITH THE GATHERING IN VIENNA OF FMS FOR THE CSCE FOLLOW-UP CONFERENCE.
