1. WEST EUROPEAN MEDIA REACTION TO SUNDAY'S GENERAL ELECTIONS RECEIVED WIDE COVERAGE IN THE AUSTRIAN PRESS. FOREIGN COMMENTATORS FOCUSED ON HAIDER'S "SENSATIONAL" SUCCESS, WHICH HAS BEEN WIDELY INTERPRETED AS A "MASSIVE

ISRAELI REACTION

2. THE ISRAELI PRESS HAS CALLED THE ELECTION RESULT "A DANGEROUS MOVE TO THE RIGHT" AND A "CONTINUATION OF THE TREND ESTABLISHED DURING THE WALDHEIM ELECTION," AUSTRIAN RADIO REPORTED TODAY. THIS DEVELOPMENT COULD ADVERSELY AFFECT FUTURE BILATERAL RELATIONS BETWEEN VIENNA AND JERUSALEM, ISRAELI PAPERS REPORTEDLY SAID. FORMER ISRAELI AMBASSADOR TO AUSTRIA, MICHAEL ELIZUR, "SHARPLY CRITICIZED" HIS GOVERNMENT'S POSITION ON AUSTRO-ISRAELI RELATIONS, THE REPORT NOTED. IT FURTHER POINTED OUT THAT THERE ARE OTHER PUBLIC VOICES IN ISRAEL WHICH FAVOR A POSITIVE SETTLEMENT OF THE CONTROVERSY BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. ACCORDING TO AN ARTICLE IN THE LATEST EDITION OF THE (INVESTIGATIVE) WEEKLY "PROFIL", THE MAGAZINE SAYS ITS EXAMINATION OF ACCUSATIONS AGAINST KURT WALDHEIM IN A DOCUMENT COMPILED BY YUGOSLAVIA DEC 18, 1947 HAS BEEN INCONCLUSIVE. IN THE COURSE OF THE WALDHEIM AFFAIR, THE YUGOSLAV PAPER "VELERNJE NOVOSTI" HAD SAID THE ARCHIVE MATERIAL (LATER FORWARDED TO THE LONDON-BASED INTERNATIONAL WAR-CRIMES COMMISSION) REVEALED CHARGES AGAINST WALDHEIM PUT FORWARD BY 2 YUGOSLAV WITNESSES, "PROFIL" SAID. (INDEPENDENT WEEKLY PROFIL, NOVEMBER 25)
--- MEANWHILE, THE "JERUSALEM POST" REPORTEDLY WROTE THAT A GOVERNMENT COMMISSION HAS FOUND ONLY "FEEBLE EVIDENCE" OF THE INVOLVEMENT OF AUSTRIAN PRESIDENT KURT WALDHEIM IN WAR CRIMES. CHANCELLOR VRANITZKY SAID HE EXPECTED NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES TO LAST 6-8 WEEKS. SPO CHAIRMAN SINOWATZ YESTERDAY AGAIN REAFFIRMED HIS PARTY'S OPPOSITION TO FORMING A COALITION WITH HAIDER'S FPO.
