1. A YEAR-IN-REVIEW THINK PIECE IN AUSTRIA'S LARGEST NEWSPAPER, KRONEN ZEITUNG, HIGHLIGHTS TECHNOLOGY AT ITS BEST AND WORSE:

"WITH A RECORD-SETTING FLIGHT, AIRCRAFT PIONEERS ENDED THE YEAR: VOYAGER CIRCLED THE GLOBE WITHOUT RE-FUELING. A TECHNOLOGICAL CATASTROPHE STARTED THE YEAR -- THE CHALLENGER EXPLOSION -- PLACING THE ENTIRE AMERICAN SPACE PROGRAM IN DOUBT. AND IN THE SPRING, TECHNOLOGICAL PROGRESS BEAMED INTO OUR LIVES IN A DANGEROUS FORM -- CHERNOBYL BECAME A SYMBOL FOR FEAR -- A CREEPING THREAT THAT CAN'T BE HEARD, SMELLED, OR SEEN -- BUT ONLY DETECTED THROUGH THE TICKING OF A GEIGER COUNTER... - UNDER THE HEADLINE, "THE PAST AS SOAP OPERA," VIENNA'S PRESTIGIOUS DAILY, DIE PRESSE, IN A YEAR-IN-REVIEW THINK PIECE, WROTE: "IT CONCERNS NOT ONLY WALDHEIM; IT CONCERNS AUSTRIA.
