# 2. MEXICO AND THE DEBT:

FINANCIAL LA TRIBUNE FRONT-PAGE ARTICLE BY REPORTER DANIELE GERVAIS: "AN ACCORD IN PRINCIPLE WHICH MUST BE ENDORSED BY PRIVATE CREDIT INSTITUTIONS AS A WHOLE. THEY WILL NOT DISAVOW THEIR REPRESENTATIVES AFTER CONDUCTING LONG-TERM COORDINATION...IT REMAINS TO BE SEEN IF THE EFFORT MADE BY THE BANKS WILL BE GAUGED AT ITS CORRECT VALUE BY THOSE WHO SEE THEM AS LARGELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEBTS OF THE THIRD WORLD.
