SUBJECT: MITTERRAND AND WALDHEIM: AUSTRIAN PRESS DISCUSSES

PARALLELS AND DIFFERENCES

1. SUMMARY: COMMENTING ON THE RECENT REVELATIONS OF THE WAR-TIME PAST OF FRENCH PRESIDENT FRANCOIS MITTERRAND, TWO LEADING AUSTRIAN NEWSPAPERS ON SEPTEMBER 14 DISCUSSED POSSIBLE PARALLELS OF THE MITTERRAND CASE AND THAT OF FORMER AUSTRIAN PRESIDENT KURT WALDHEIM. THE DAILY "DIE PRESSE" -- AN UNWAVERING WALDHEIM ALLY SINCE 1986 --LAMENTED THAT, WHILE MITTERRAND WOULD LIKELY EMERGE UNSCATHED WALDHEIM IS UNFORGIVEN. BY CONTRAST, THE TABLOID "KURIER" -- WHICH HAS BEEN HIGHLY CRITICAL OF WALDHEIM ALL ALONG -- NOTED THAT MITTERRAND'S FRANK ADMISSION OF HIS WAR-TIME PAST DEFLECTED SHARP CRITICISM,

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WHILE WALDHEIM'S DENIALS EXPOSED HIM AND DISCREDITED HIM FOREVER. END SUMMARY.

"DIE PRESSE" REPLAYS ITS FAVORITE THEME: LOOK AT THE DOUBLE STANDARDS ON THE PART OF ANTI-WALDHEIM LIBERALS

2. IN A FRONT-PAGE COMMENTARY ON SEPTEMBER 14, THE EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE CONSERVATIVE VIENNA DAILY "DIE PRESSE", THOMAS CHORHERR -- FOR YEARS A PROLIFIC AND UNWAVERING VOICE IN DEFENSE OF WALDHEIM'S HONOR ---SARCASTICALLY NOTED THE STRIKING PARALLELS UNCOVERED IN THE WAR-TIME PAST OF FRENCH PRESIDENT MITTERRAND, FORMER AUSTRIAN PRESIDENT WALDHEIM, AND THE EMINENT GERMAN LITERARY CRITIC REICH-RANICKI. (FYI. REICH-RANICKI REPORTEDLY COLLABORATED WITH THE POLISH SECRET SERVICE IN LONDON TO REPATRIATE POLISH EXILES SHORTLY AFTER THE WAR. END FYI.) CHORHERR LAMENTED THAT "WHILE THREE INDIVIDUALS HAD DONE SIMILAR THINGS, ALAS, THE PUBLIC CERTAINLY DEVELOPED A HIGHLY SELECTIVE PERCEPTION OF WHAT ARE ANALOGOUS CASES." "WHY DOES THE PUBLIC EXCUSE MITTERRAND (AND REICH-RANICKI) FROM ALMOST EVERYTHING, WHILE FORGIVING WALDHEIM HARDLY ANYTHING?" CHORHERR ASSERTED THE FACT MITTERRAND WAS A SOCIALIST EXPLAINED THE DIFFERENT TREATMENT OF THE TWO PRESIDENTS. (FYI. IN THE PAST CHORHERR'S FLAMING JOURNALISM IN DEFENSE OF WALDHEIM REPEATEDLY ATTACKED THE LEFT-WING INTELLECTUALS FOR SELECTIVELY JUDGING THE MORALS OF PUBLIC FIGURES SUCH AS WALDHEIM. END FYI.)

A WALDHEIM-CRITICAL "KURIER" SEES FEW PARALLELS BUT MANY DIFFERENCES

3. THE FOREIGN POLICY EDITOR OF "KURIER," OTTO KLAMBAUER, ALSO FOCUSED ON PARALLELS BETWEEN MITTERRAND'S WARTIME RECORD AND THAT OF WALDHEIM. (FYI: "KURIER" HAS BEEN CONTINUOUSLY CRITICAL OF WALDHEIM THROUGHOUT THE AFFAIR. END FYI.) HOWEVER, KLAMBAUER GAVE SEVERAL REASONS WHY, IN HIS VIEW, CRITICISM OF MITTERRAND HAS BEEN, AND IS LIKELY TO REMAIN, CONSIDERABLY MORE MODERATE THAN THAT OF WALDHEIM. WHILE REVELATIONS ABOUT WALDHEIM'S WAR-TIME PAST CAME DURING HIS PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN, MITTERRAND IS NEARING THE END OF HIS POLITICAL CAREER. MOREOVER, MITTERRAND HAS TAKEN A FORWARD STRATEGY REGARDING SPECULATION OVER HIS PAST, WHILE WALDHEIM STONEWALLED AND COVERED UP HIS RECORD. KLAMBAUER CONCLUDED: "NOBODY OUTSIDE FRANCE TODAY THINKS ABOUT INTERFERING IN THE INNER-FRENCH DEBATE." WITH WALDHEIM, THE OPPOSITE WAS TRUE.

COMMENT

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4. ALTHOUGH CHORHERR'S LATEST ARTICLE IN DEFENSE OF WALDHEIM DOES NOT COME AS A SURPRISE TO THE POLITICAL OBSERVER, HIS WELL PLACED EDITORIAL DISCOURSE ABOUT "EQUAL TREATMENT" OF PRESIDENTS WITH WAR-TIME PASTS MAY BE ONE MORE ELEMENT IN AN ORCHESTRATED CAMPAIGN TO REHABILITATE WALDHEIM. THIS IS NOT CLEAR. WHAT IS EVIDENT IS THE

IMPLICIT ASSUMPTION THAT CITIZENS AND LEADERS OF AUSTRIA, A COUNTRY DEFEATED IN WORLD WAR II, AND FRANCE, A COUNTRY LIBERATED IN WORLD WAR II, WILL OR SHOULD BE TREATED IN THE SAME MANNER. WHILE "KURIER" CLEARLY TAKES A LESS DEFENSIVE POSITION IN DISCUSSING MITTERRAND AND WALDHEIM, ITS FOREIGN POLICY EDITOR KLAMBAUER HIGHLIGHTS THE IRONY THAT A COUNTRY WHOSE INTELLECTUAL ELITE CASTIGATED WALDHEIM FOR YEARS, NOW FINDS ITSELF ENTANGLED IN A MORE OR LESS ANALOGOUS SOUL SEARCHING DEBATE.
