List of Americans in Argentina Confiscated in Argentina

During a recent operation against the Montoneros in Buenos Aires Province, security forces confiscated a document dated 20 February 1974 which listed Americans in Argentina, including some members of the United States diplomatic mission. The list included the individual's name, the names and ages of his children, home address and telephone number, and place and address of employment, including business telephone number and extension. An accompanying memorandum stated that the list lacked some 200 names, but that an attempt would be made to add to it and keep it current. The author of the memorandum assured that further data on the names could be obtained if desired. Twenty-three names identified with the U.S. mission are listed; however, all but two of these individuals have now permanently departed Argentina.
