





AREA NOTE

There are indica-Haiti: tions that Haitian military leaders, including Chief of Staff Constant, are becoming demoralized and doubtful of their ability to deal with the small but apparently well-armed group of exiles who invaded Haiti last The rebels, estimated to number about 30, are apparently still at large in the mountainous region northeast of Saltrou, where they landed. The rebels are being pursued, but government forces have been unable to engage them in bottle. inability of the Maitian Army and militia to maintain contact with the rebel group is an increasing psychological advantage to the rebels.
