AREA NOTE

Haiti: There are indications ~~that~~ Haitian military leaders, including Chief of Staff Constant, are becoming demoralized and doubtful of their ability to deal with the small but apparently well-armed group of exiles who invaded Haiti last week. The rebels, estimated to number about 30, are apparently still at large in the mountainous region northeast of Saltrou, where they landed. The rebels are being pursued, but government forces have been unable to engage them in battle. The inability of the Haitian Army and militia to maintain contact with the rebel group is an in-

creasing psychological advantage to the rebels.

The government is considering burning a number of houses and fields to flush out the rebels and to serve as a warning to inhabitants not to aid the rebels.

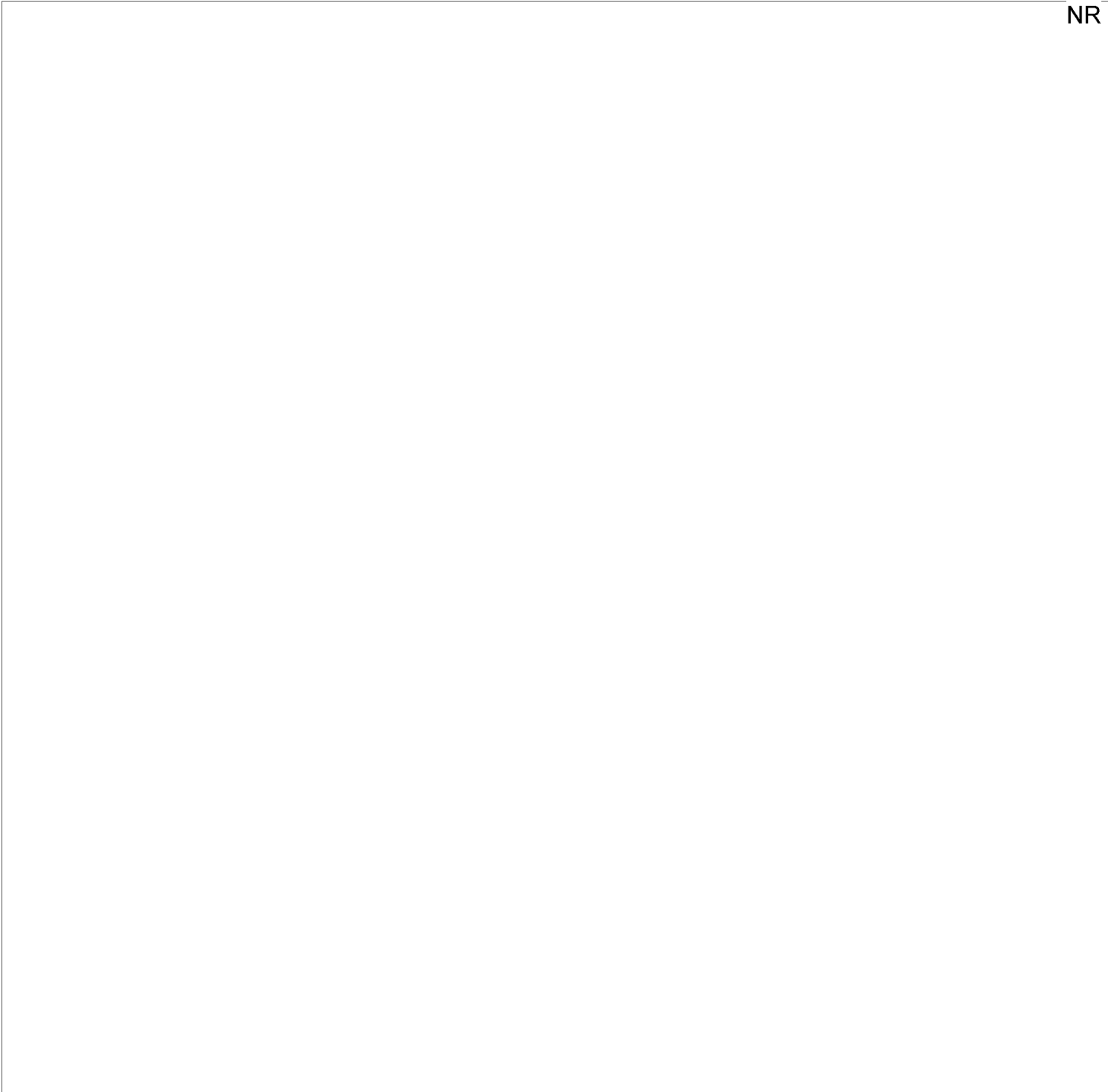
