

(U) While traveling the world is a normal part of the job for many CIA officers, traveling to fictional lands is not. Nevertheless, that is exactly what former <u>Deputy Director David Cohen</u> did this past weekend, when he appeared as a nondescript Northerner during Sunday's (21 April) episode of *Game of Thrones*.
