SUBJECT: Request for Fuel and Refrigeration

1. WEBER, who is the organization's field representative for matters pertaining to Czechoslovakia, lives on Starnberger See. I know that he and his pregnant wife have been without heat for one or more months. This difficulty is probably caused by the remoteness of his location. Because I work closely with WEBER, I feel that it would be helpful if we could take any steps to see that he gets delivery of some coal.

2. The WEBERS are also without refrigeration. An ice box is impractical because they live in such a remote spot that delivery of ice could not be made. I am aware that it is probably impossible to get him a refrigerator. He has a refrigerator with a motor built for 220 Direct Current. The current in his present house is alternating. It would cost about 200 DM to convert to motor. If a refrigerator can not be secured for this house, which is American-requisitioned property, please inform me so that I may ask for an additional sum of 200 DM for this purpose.
