- 2. The Basel telephone director, reveals that the Trachafteund Sozialhile Durope (MISO) and the CRICO Internationals Handelsanstalt are both located at Alisabethenstrasse 1, Basel. However, each firm has its own telephone number, which are listed as follows:

The Chamber of Commerce indicated that BRIN was also interested in a number of other small businesses.

- 5. Regarding ARTOS, Source noted that there was no secretary at this firm. The only person he observed there, once when he called at the office and once when he telephoned to the office, was KOHN. Source is of the opinion that ARTOS probably engages in trade in textiles through the firm BRIN & Co. On one occasion when Source telephoned to ARTOS, Source asked KOHN whether he would be interested in purchasing briquottes for Sactorn Germany. KOHN did not register any interest until Source said that there was a rather large order possible, at which point KOHN told him to come to the office. Thinking that KCHN might have another office other than ABTOS, Source saked where he could meet KOHN. RAHN told him that his office is located at Elisabethenstrasse 1.
- with reference to paragraph 3 a. and b. of BONR-0108 you are advised that the Carich tolephon, directory lists both SURFIER & Cis. and TOWNOCHET-Laboratorium as located at Andoneretrasse 130. Source In Chance LLE of soked this 'addition and found not a factory but a very old building which contains the office of SCHRUILR b bie., sphere of Thymodont toothphete. Despite the fact that the telephone directory indicates that nome nort of inclory in located at the above address, Jource say no signs of any facilities for the production of toothpaste. At Eddenorstrasse 130, Source spoke with a roman about 40 jears old who stated that Isak ASCHER R was out. The woman, when questioned by Source, agreed that the firm made toothpants and mouth washes. Source then teleghoned to the office number, expecting to get the woman at Endemoratraces 130, instead he got SCHN\_ILR at his private address: Zeltweg 57, Surich. Source inquired whether SCHNTLER would be willing to sell toothpaste to Austern Germany. SCHNLIER said he would and invited Source to come to got him.

- 8. Re paragraph ] c: FALKINE should undoubtedly read FALKINEX AG., which is located at Freigutetrases 6, Zurich, where it cocupies two small rooms. The firm was founded in 1947 with the usual minimum empitalization of 50,000 Sfre. It is owned and managed solely by J. S. FALK, a Swiss citizen of Polish-Jovich erigin, who lives at Bleicherweg 37, Zurich. It has been reported on good authority that this firm is engaged in purchasing activities on behalf of Poland. FALKINEX specializes in metals but is also known to have used inquiries concerning machinery and electronic equipment. For its more delicate inquiries addressed to Western European countries, chisfly England, FALKINEX uses the cover address, INTERNATIONALE HUFTLEMPLODUXTE, Vadus, Licahtenstein. Mail is daily forwarded to FALK in Zurich from this address.

- 9. Re paragraph 3 is The first Gebralar GROB operator a butchers' machinery office at Diemerstranse 30, Estich, and an expertingor's office at Diemerstranse 20, Claridenhof, Estich. In May 1948 a report was received from a reliable source that Gebrular BROB was buying arms for the Communists. (F. ]-18.) 10. Re paragraph ] et Seurce [ ] checked en BUSASIA AG., which is an impert-export firm, located at Rheinfelders trusse 10, Basel. The Basel Chamber of Commerce had a record on this firm which was founded in 1947. The head of the firm was listed as [are] Silvin APPA. Asseciated with her is one Jean SUMMUTZ, who is listed as living at Rheinfelderstrasse 14, Basel. The firm is listed as dealing in chamical products, machines, clocks, tools and articles of all sorts. Source was informed at the Chamber of Commerce that EURASIA dealt particularly with the Hear and Far East.

11. Source went to Eheinfelderstrasse 10 and found that it was an apartment house. The name TAPA appeared on one of the letter boxes. Source noted Mrs. ZAPA going into her apartment and described her as a woman about 15 years of age, thin in build, with reddish hair. Source learned that Mrs. TAPA is married to one Andrea TAPA, also living at Rheinfelderstrasse 10, and a technician by profession. Source telephoned Mrs. ZAPA one evening and noked her whether she was interested in selling anything to hastern Cornany. Mrs. ZAPPA said that at that very moment her firm was undergoing a change in its internal structure and that she could not undertake any new business consituents until after 14 May, when the changes would be published at the Chamber of Commerce. She invited Source to each her cometime during the week beginning 14 May.

<u>HOTS</u>: Source called our attention to the fact that the records of the Chamber of Commerce indicated that quite a number of persons have been in and out of EURASIA since it was founded in 1947.

12. C 3-19163, dated 6 March 1951, states that a contrast which is being Regetiated between the DDR and EURASIA is exciting the approval of HIAM (We do not know the significance of this abbreviation). This contract calls for the delivery by EURASIA of 100 tone foundry coft-lead (Entten-Voichblei) in exchange for chemicals to the value of \$136,000.

13. Re paragraph 3 f: Eail BUGI, an import-export firm, located at Burgunderstrasse 28, Solethurn, is not listed in the Swise Trade Registry. When Source = ealled at the above address HUGI was not at home. On the next day, Source telephoned to HUGI and asked whether he was interested in selling a large order of briquettes in Eastern Germany and whether he could deliver

the order to Eastern Germany. HUGI secued interested and invited Source to call on him at his office. A check of the files of this office reveals no traces on Mail HUGI.

14. Re paragraph 4 of HOBRO AG, is located at Gotthardstrasse 6, Turish. Early in 1950 HOBRO underwent various changes and at the same time a new company was founded in Bern under the suspices of HCERO, vis. the CLOCKA-Handelsgeeellschaft a.b.H., Muhlemett-struces 62, Bern, with a capitalization of 20,000 Sfrs. Investigation revealed that OLCCHA had been set up by HCBRO for the purpose of carrying on business with INTRAC, since HCBRO was concentrating on trade with the Russian Zone of Germany and did not wish to become too well known by monopolizing this field as well as trade with the Russians in Vienna. OLCCHA was therefore to take over the latter field for HCBRO. It was learned that OLCCHA was founded as the successor to the bankrupt OLCC company in Bern which had specialized in the expert-import of machinery. (MIST-255.)

15. Re paragraph 4 by The Swiss tolephone directory lists a Sladinir RARISCELE-Weber as living at Habsburgetrasse 17. Bern; and a Vadim/MARISKEIN, employee at the United Mations, residing at Chesin Eries. Geneva. A check of our files reveals the following probable trace:

Count NAVISCHAINE: Licentenstein national of Thite Russian extraction living at Clarens. Age about 43, about 1.90 m tall, well-built, blond hair, rather bald, blue eyes, long face. Thought to be connected with the house of Lischtenstein. Previously lived at Vienna. NAVISOUGIBS is a fanatical anti-communist and was on friendly terms with von ERGELBRECHTER, German Consul at Geneva. Source cons into contact with MAYISONAINE with the departure of you SROULEREGITER and need him as a link with the Polish ergonisation. NAVISCHEINE is described as a very sincere and serious-ainded purson who by virtue of his "European" outlook in claimed to be of possible interest to the Allies. (Source: Interrogation Report on Rans von PLOCATORE, June 1945. It has been assumed all along that HAVISSURING and MARISCHEIN are identical. There is nothing to prove that this is so - on the other hand it would seen that the spelling of NAVISOHKING were definitely incorrect,)

16. Re paragraph 4 c: A check of our files reveals no traces on Harry TONG-Johnston, also the Population Office in Zurich has no rederd of anyone by that name. Source I , however, reported that Case 372 is located at the post office in the Zurich-Enge railroad station, and that the postal number for Zurich-Enge is Zurich 27.

17. It will be noted from F ]=17222 (copies of which were distributed to Karleruhe) that SCHNLIER & Cie., PALZIECX AG., and HOHRO AG., all of Zurich, are seting as intermediaries in procuring scarce materials for the orbit countries from Testern Europe. As can be seen from the results of our investigations, such of the information reported in BORN-CIOS has been confirmed insofar as addresses and firm names are concerned. However, as stated in E 3-3565, we are unable to answer all your questions with regard to business deals of the firms mentioned.

18. Should you desire further information on WISO and ARTOS, it is suggested that our Basel police limison be queried.
