STRIBBARDT's statement concerned his alleged intelligence activities for the United States and French Intelligence Services from October 1950 to January 1953, at which time STRIBBARDT allegedly gave up his intelligence work. The aforementioned statement was made for the Ametrian Police by STRIBBARDT on 13 February 1953. (Unevaluated)

A/R V-34892; HG - 02589 dated 10 June 1953, Subject: "Viedemann, (fnu), GIS; Suspected GIS Activities, Vienna", a report from Informant 18GL dated 19 March 1953, which mentions STRIMHARTY as a person known to one Mrs. Pekelsky as Earel OVRK, and working as an agent for the CSR State Police (St3). STRIMMENT was alleged by Mrs. Pekelsky to be working for CIC, Lins. STRIMHARDY allegedly warned another Grech agent in Innsbruck, a Professor (fnn) Germy, of Germy's impending arrest, allowing Germy to secape. Material left behind by Germy was allegedly brought to Lins, and then to Urfahr, Instria by STRIMHARDY and then turned over to an Eastern Intelligence Agency. (B-3)

TWE Message No. 0-557 dated 19 February 1953, from Region "G" to Meadquarters, 430th DIG Detachment, SUBJECT: "Earl STRIMMARUT", which mentions that a brief interview with STRIMMAR'T on 18 February 1953 revealed that STRIMMARUT left from Amstralia for Anstria on 8 Hovember 1952, allegedly on behalf of Robert Vogeler. STRIMHEUT allegedly was making preparations for mission to enter the CSR with one Tony Kandrad, a Canadian citizen, in order to bring out William Catiz and John Hyasta, then prisoners in CSE.
