SUBJECT: @ PARKET

REF: See Agenda KUEHNE_ C - Meeting 2 April 1954

At a meeting on 2 April 1954 @ KUEHNE informed [____] that in his opinion, apart from the security considerations involved, @ PARKER conducted his group in a very business-like and efficient manner both administratively and operationally as well. He added that @ PARKER, because of his personal business experience and background would definitely be well suited to attempting legal type operations. As a final recommendation, but for the current failure to resolve the security aspects of this case, @ KUEHNE pointed out that @ PARKER would probably be a suitable person to head up a combined CSR and Polish field agency as suggested by our 1 January letter. Personally, he added, he would like to resolve the security aspects involved in this affair by every means possible, even including the complete use of LCFLUTTER. He expressed the hope that a final decision on this case could be made in the very near future.
