2. WORM: When asked what had been turned up here KUNZE hedged. When asked point blank if WORM still was a staffer, KUNZE said she was pretty sure he was.

5 Jan 1962

3. Frank WORM: KUNZE said WORM still was working for UPHILL. PHILLIPS said he had checked and learned that at the time we had voiced our earlier suspicions of WORM, PHILLIPS had made a serious security investigation -- the results of which (PHILLIPS' report) had been negative. The results had been negative; it was not clear WORM had anything of value in his background, that he had been a member of the Communist Party, and that he had been a member of the Communist Party. PHILLIPS was currently reviewing the WORM case and did not yet know if it would be possible to launch another investigation.
