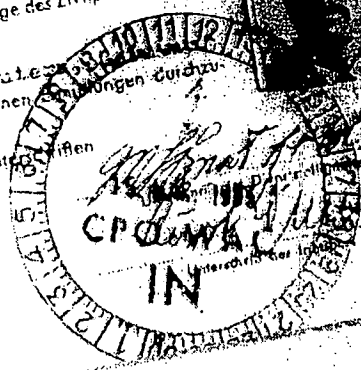

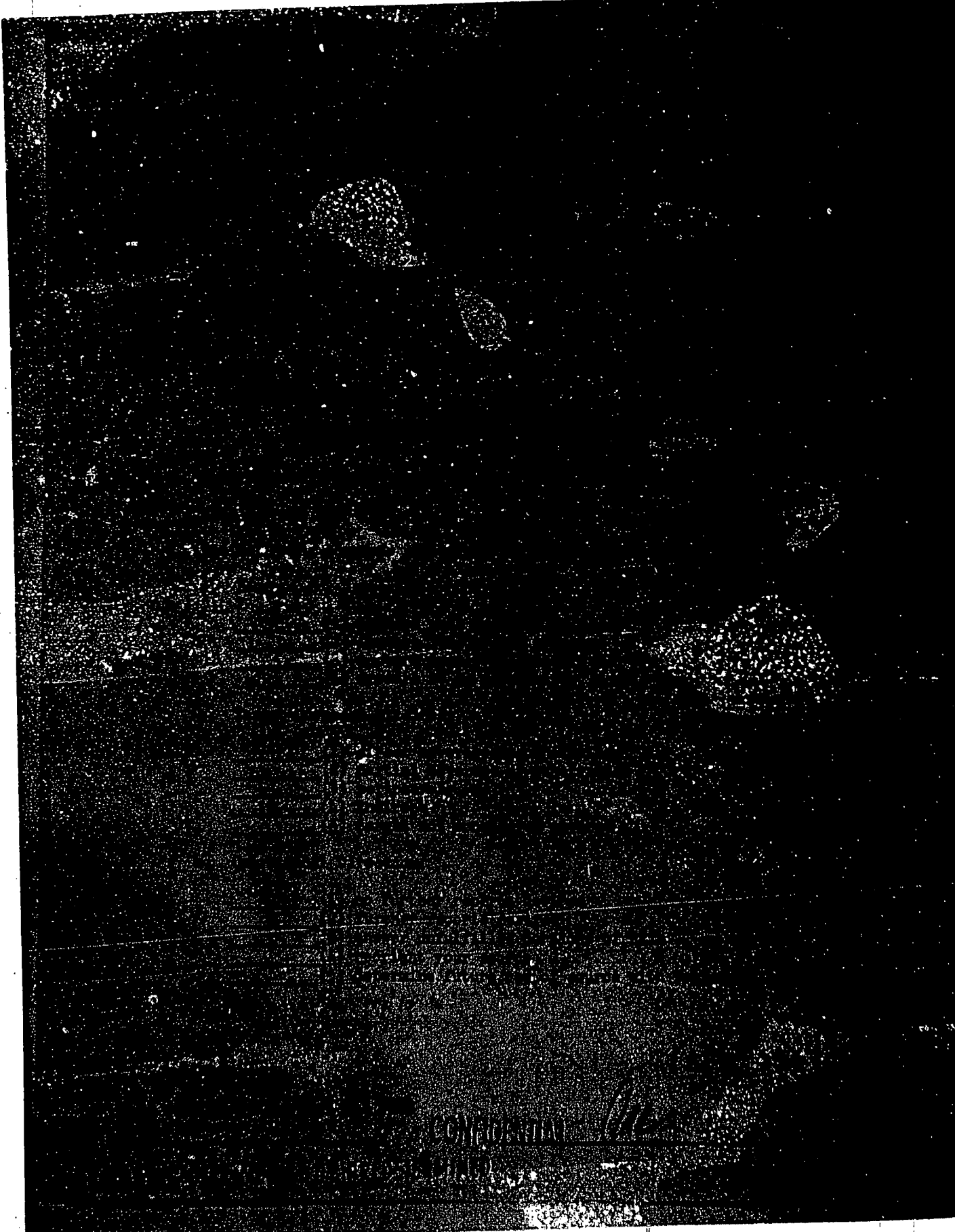

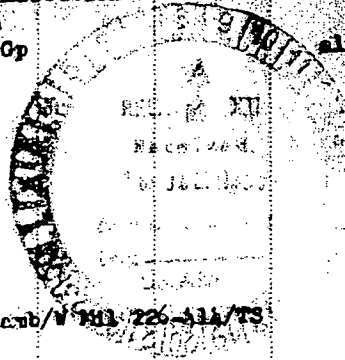

b. SUBJECT started work with the Gestapo in 1935 as an office worker in 1935. He became a Kriminalassistent in 1936 at the Fuhrerschule for Security Police in BERLIN. He was discharged in 1943 (nine (9) months) then returned to work as a Kriminalassistent where he remained until taken prisoner in May 1945. During his employment with the Gestapo SUBJECT conducted all types of investigations and participated in all phases of police work. Since his employment with this Region SUBJECT has been utilized to effect agency checks and neighborhood interviews, all of which he conducted in a discreet and efficient manner.

c. SUBJECT was a member of the NSDAP during the war but since 1945 he has not been associated with any political party or group.

d. SUBJECT's sister Erna WUNDERLICH has resided in Wittenberg near GERA, Land Thuringia, East Germany, from early 1945 to the present. To the best of SUBJECT's knowledge and belief his sister has never been in the city of DRESDEN. SUBJECT stated that his sister, as well as the rest of his family, are strongly anti-communist and have never been associated with the Communist Party or any of its affiliates. 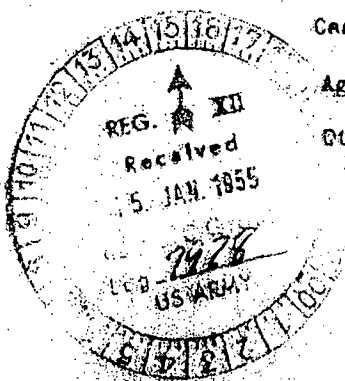

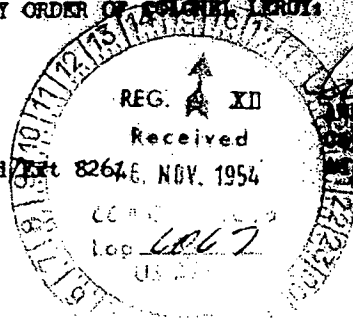
