Carded and Registry information reveals that Paul ZAPP was the commanding officer of the Einsatzkommando III and SD commander for Laurien/The Crimea from 1941 to 1943. He was an SS Obersturmbahnruehrer with the EDS in the Crimea in March 1943, second in command to BIRKAMP before Dr. LEYSCH, then remained at Kinsevitze Gruppe D (Headquarters). He was at Pres. Mitovsk in March 1943 and in Constanta, Romania in April 1944. He was assigned as the Fuehrer SD Leitabschnitt and FdS in Dresden in May 1944. He was possibly in Vienna in June 1944. He was assigned NSMAP # 1383288 and SS 710710.

Kurt WALTER was listed as an SS man in the Hun-gerian and Yugoslav Black Lists. We have no additional information. Quentzinger in Driftin Reich quoted an article from the 31 December 1942 issue of "Banaler Vorposten" which states that one Herbert WIKER, no microscopic data given, was an SS-Untersturmfuehrer of the WaFFen-SS in Weihenhoef. This Herbert WIKER may be identical with Herbert WIKER (0117/61845), born 16 June 1905 in Lauterbach, West Prussia.

In no additional information concerning Heinz [redacted] [redacted] no information identifiable with [redacted] [redacted] The above information may be passed to CAPINE without source descriptions.
