1. Information on file at this headquarters reveals that Helmut ZBOROWSKI, born 21 August 1905 in THERESIENSTADT, was arrested by the US Forces on 28 June 1946 at DACHAU and charged with having been Hauptsturmfuehrer in the Waffen SS and an Untersturmfuehrer in the Allgemeine SS. SUBJECT was also a member of the NSDAP, the NSKK, the DAF, the NSV, and the Deutsche Studentenschaft. Investigation revealed that SUBJECT was an engineer and inventor and that HIS membership and rank in the SS were honorary and as such, HE was not chargeable under the NUERNBERG verdict. SUBJECT was released from custody on 22 August 1947. (B-2)
2. Information dated May 1948 reveals that one Dr. Helmut Zborowski, in charge of the Rocket Development Group in B.M.W. (sic), not further identified, was requested to be evacuated to the United Kingdom for approximately two (2) weeks. (Unevaluated)
3. Information dated June 1950 reveals that one Helmut Zborowski, an engineer, residing at El de la Republique, ST CLOUD, France, not further identified, was a member of the Society for Interplanetary Research. (Unevaluated)
4. Available records disclose no further pertinent information.
