1. We are attaching the latest CARAVEL reports, given us by \_\_\_\_\_
2. The following items appear to be of CART interest:
  - a. Hans-Walter ~~KECK~~ ~~HEINRICH~~ is mentioned in ~~MEMO-3614~~ as a former British agent during and after World War II, who fell out with the British and denounced a number of SPD and CDU politicians as British agents.
  - b. ~~KEITZCH~~ case: See ~~MOG-19824~~, 30 June 53, the last cover sheet on a CARAVEL report.
  - c. Ursula ~~BECKE~~ will be remembered from ~~UNROLLERY 8~~. We will notify ~~FCB~~ of this incident. It will probably make them unhappy, though.
  - d. Guenther ~~LATE~~: Our only trace is ~~MEMO-2006~~, 5 June 53, which is a BV trace request stating that he is supposed to have connections to the SSD. This case appears good confirmation for the supposition that the SSD is now operating deep into the Federal Republic.
  - e. Frantisek ~~CHALOUPK~~: A firm ~~CHALOUPK~~ is said to work for the Slovak separatists at Camp Valka. He is a suspected StB agent.
