against Mussolini's life to subject who forwarded the info to ~~ZIMMER~~ BISMARCK who in turn gave it to Italian police, blowing source, and showing Italian police he worked in intelligence network in Rome contrary to Rome-Berlin pact. Zimmer recalled to Berlin and saved thru intervention of an influential uncle from sacking..." LECHNER therefore considers subject incompetent intelligence officer. Subject returned to Italy as Leiter, Abt VI, Aussenkdo Milan, in Feb 44. Subject failed to do anything to save Prof. Z ICCARDI @ ZUCCA when latter was picked up by Abt IV, AKC Milan in fall of 44. Ziccardi at time of arrest had subject's photo on person, which had been given him by PARRILI so that a false identity card could be made for subject under some other name. Attention called to two articles in Sat Eve Post on 22 and 29 Sept, it being felt importance of role assigned to subject and Parrili is unfortunate exaggeration. Summing up document: a) Subj. effective contribution to Italian resistance activities was negligible and predicated upon fact that as an abt VI officer he looked at things in more subtle way than ABT iV. b) Real measure of work as Abt VI officer is found by reference to attachments which indicate he did not lie down on job. c) Re. subject's ability and potentialities, Lechner's opinion (i.e., subject is incompetent intelligence officer) should not be taken lightly. Document states Zimmer should not be treated differently from General Wolff, who was placed at disposition of CSDIC and thoroughly exploited

before being moved to Nuremberg for War Crimes trials. Should be given complete interrogation.
