MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Approach by McCord to Agency Employee in 1971

The Office of Security reports that in the fall of 1971 James McCord approached [redacted] currently an employee of the Office of Security, to accept part-time employment installing alarm systems. [redacted] declined the offer because he felt he was not qualified for it and that the work would be inconsistent with his employment. [redacted] had subsequent contacts with McCord, the last being by telephone several months ago.
