**(U) Are You at an Agency Facility? Pokémon NO!**

(U) Pokémon GO is a new, location-based augmented reality mobile application, released on 6 July, for Android and iOS devices. It uses smartphone Global Positioning Systems (GPS) to spawn Pokémon characters in real-world locations, including Agency-controlled facilities and compounds. The game uses several smartphone capabilities, including the camera, to virtually capture the characters and photograph the encounter.

(U) Agency employees should adhere to the following guidance regarding the use of Pokémon GO:

- (U//~~FOUO~~) Agency employees are not authorized to capture Pokémon "characters" while in or around Agency-controlled facilities [Redacted]
