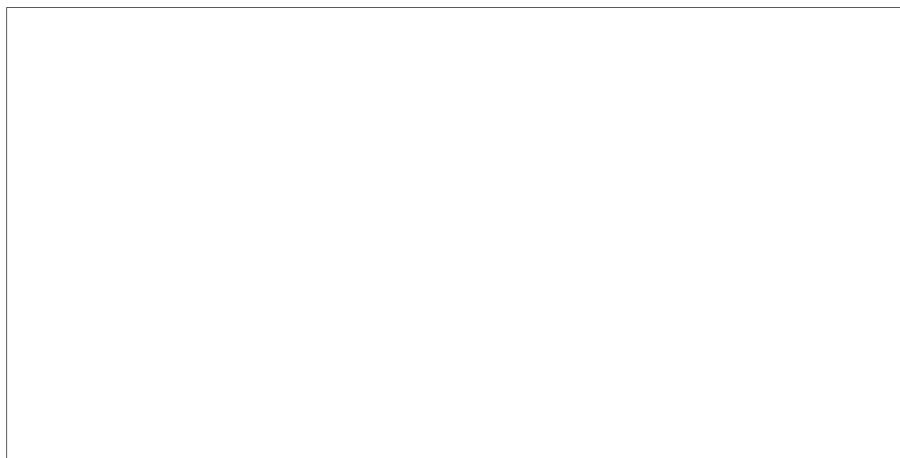

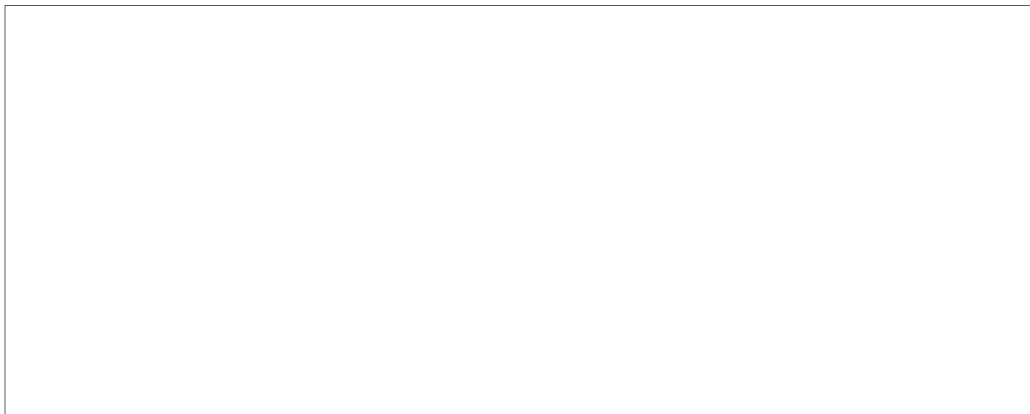

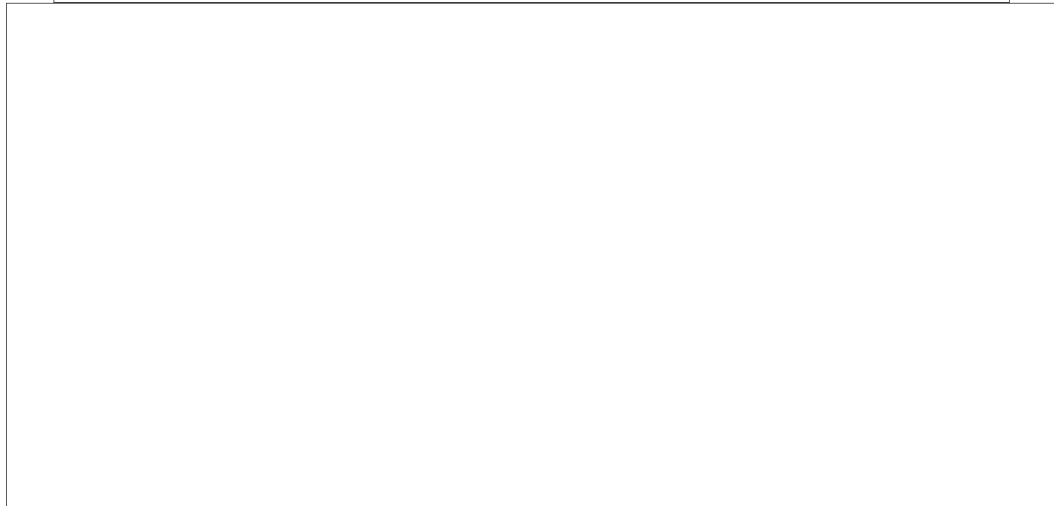

Malawi: [Plotting against the authoritarian regime of pro-Western Prime Minister Banda continues. Reports give varying dates for an assassination attempt against Banda; according to the latest report, dissidents plan to act during the anniversary celebrations of Malawi's independence on 5 and 6 July. Since the collapse of the guerrilla effort during the spring and the departure of their leader, Henry Chipembere, to the US for medical treatment, the dissidents have repeatedly stated that assassination is the only way to get rid of Banda]
