

POLITICAL ANALYST

Your role: You assess the domestic politics and international relations of foreign governments and entities, examining their goals and motivations, ideologies, resources and capabilities, decision making processes, and the impact of those elements on US interests.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one **blue** (political) gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to the number of blue gems on your location to get reporting to either place in the reports circle **or** reduce the crisis

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: You are highly effective at building networks among collectors who work political issues, and can leverage that network to help your colleagues. Players who are collocated with you can roll one additional die when rolling for reporting if there are any blue gems on the Collector Space.

MILITARY ANALYST

Your role: You evaluate the strategic capabilities, intentions, and decision making of foreign national security establishments and non-state actors such as terrorist and insurgency groups, and examine political-military issues such as civil-military relations, regional security arrangements, military diplomacy, and peacekeeping operations.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one **red** (military) gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to the number of red gems on your location to get reporting to either place in the reports circle **or** reduce the crisis

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: You are highly effective at building networks among collectors who work military issues, and can leverage that network to help your colleagues. Players who are collocated with you can roll one additional die when rolling for reporting if there are any red gems on your current location.

ECONOMIC ANALYST

Your role: You assess economic, trade, and financial issues that affect US security interests. You might look broadly at the macroeconomic and microeconomic issues facing foreign countries, or delve deeply into illicit financial activities, including terrorist and criminal networks, money laundering, or foreign corruption.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one **green** (economic) gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to the number of green gems on your location to get reporting to either place in the reports circle or reduce the crisis

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: You are highly effective at building networks among collectors who work economic issues, and can leverage that network to help your colleagues. Players who are collocated with you can roll one additional die when rolling for reporting if there are any green gems on your current location.

COLLECTION ANALYST

Your role: You apply your expertise on US intelligence collection systems, capabilities, processes, and policies to examine collection developments, their effect on analysis, and develop strategies to overcome collection challenges.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one of **any color** gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to half the number (rounded up) of any one color of gem on your space to get a report of that color for the reports circle. You **cannot** use reporting to reduce the crisis level.

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: Your understanding of collection capabilities can help make all collectors more responsive to analysts' needs. Players collocated with you benefit from a temporary +1 to any collectors level on the Response Ladder when rolling for reporting.

LEADERSHIP ANALYST

Your role: You seek to understand the intent and activities of foreign decision-makers, providing the insights that US policymakers need to anticipate the motivations and activities of their foreign counterparts, or to understand the actions of key non-state actors around the globe.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one **blue** (political) gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to the number of blue gems on your location to get reporting to either place in the reports circle **or** reduce the crisis

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: Your support to State Department policymakers and use of open source reporting has built relationships and knowledge you can leverage on behalf of colleagues. Players collocated with you benefit from a **temporary +1** to OSE's or STATE's level on the Response Ladder when rolling for reporting.

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & WEAPONS ANALYST

Your role: You analyze challenging national security issues including foreign weapons development, weapons proliferation, cyber warfare, and emerging technologies, applying your scientific and technical knowledge to solve complex intelligence problems.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one **red** (military) gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to the number of red gems on your location to get reporting to either place in the reports circle **or** reduce the crisis

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: Your in-depth technical knowledge has built bridges to technical collectors you can leverage on behalf of colleagues. Players collocated with you benefit from a **temporary +1** to NGA's or NSA's level on the Response Ladder when rolling for reporting.

TARGETING ANALYST

Your role: You bring analysis and operations together, unique datasets and network analysis to identify key figures and organizations who pose a threat to the US, and evaluate the risks and benefits of proposed operations to disrupt their activities.

On your turn you may take two actions in any combination of the following:

- **Move** to a different collector in the same scenario, OR to the same collector in different scenario
- **Engage** by placing one of **any color** gem your current location
- **Roll** a number of dice equal to half the number (rounded up) of any one color gem on your location to get a report of that color to either place in the reports circle **or** reduce the crisis level.

At the end of your turn, **draw a Collection Card** and resolve it as instructed.

Collaboration Bonus: Your support to collection operations helps certain collectors more effectively use the resources they have at hand to find useful sources. Players collocated with you benefit from a **temporary +1** to DH's, DO's, or NSA's level on the Response Ladder when rolling for reporting.
