This is a final response to your 26 June 2018 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, received in the office of the Information and Privacy Coordinator on 26 June 2018, for emails, memos, letters, talking points, reports, briefings and other records relating to or mentioning meetings between then Director Pompeo and William "Bill" Binney, including but not limited to the meeting on October 27, 2017.
