According to a reliable source in Pamplona, Province of Navarre, by 18 July 1947, the Junta of Defense and Armament of the Western Pyrenees had completed the following fortification construction work. Comparison with the cited previous report reveals that all the construction areas listed below - with the exception of the last three - are included within Subsector 34; the last three mentioned are part of Subsector 33. The numbers in the 200-series which appear next to the geographical locations stand for "resistance centers" into which the subsectors are divided.
