SUBJECT: BREICH, Jakob

1. Reference is made to the teletype request of 16 December 1954 from Mr. Sullivan of the Department of State requesting information contained in a Displaced Persons Commission Report concerning Jakob BREICH.

2. Information contained in a report dated 20 December 1950 from Robert J. Corbary, Coordinator for Europe of the Displaced Persons Commission Headquarters, Frankfurt, Germany to the United States Displaced Persons Commission Headquarters, Washington, D.C., reflects that Jakob BREICH, born 30 January 1911, served with the German SS Division Viking from July 1942 until May 1945. He also served in the Reserve Army from 1939 to 1942. This information was contained in a CIC report dated 17 October 1950 (documentation unavailable).
