Re: U.S. v. Mitchell et al., Criminal No. 74-110

This is in response to your telephone call of 19 July 1974 in which you raised various matters concerning the appearance of General Vernon Walters in the forthcoming trial of the captioned case. This is to advise that there is no necessity for a subpoena to be issued. General Walters will be available to testify; however, as I indicated, we would appreciate as much advance notice as possible as to the extent of timing so as to avoid any conflict with possible travel plans.
