

Dear Mr. Jaworski:

The Director has requested that I forward to you a copy of his 24 June 1974 letter to Chairman Ervin of the Senate Select Committee on Presidential Campaign Activities. This letter discusses our efforts with that Committee to be cooperative with respect to sanitization/declassification procedures regarding documents provided by the Agency as well as testimony of current and former Agency employees.
