



MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Bill Nelson called this date to advise that Seymour Bolton had told him that Jim Ludlum, at the time he was in charge of narcotics matters for the DDP, knew Liddy and was probably involved with Hunt. At that same time Lou Conein was working at the White House and Ludlum wanted to meet Conein. It is Bolton's understanding that Hunt may have introduced Ludlum to Conein.

Nelson queried as to what would be the best procedure. The writer advised that we should interview Ludlum concerning his relations with Liddy, Hunt, and Conein, and that this office would do so.
