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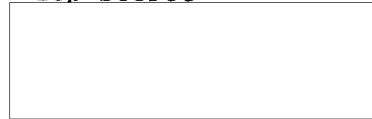
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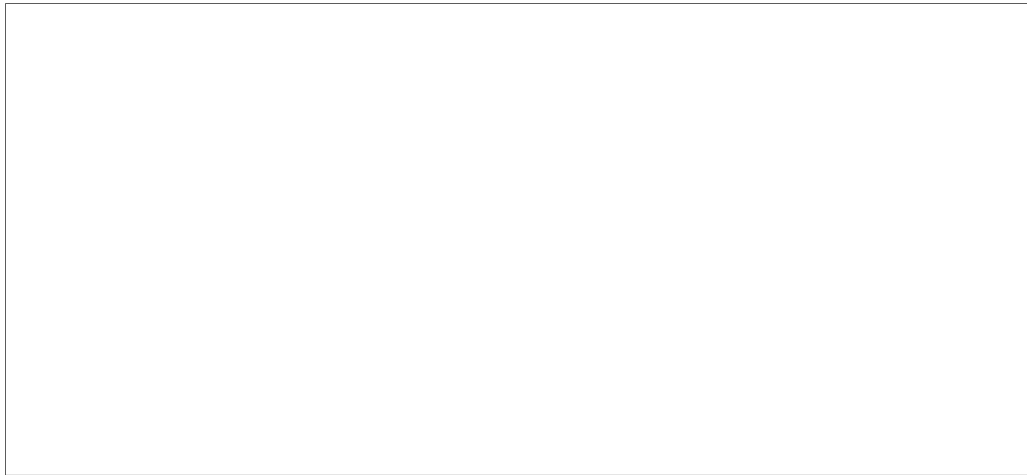
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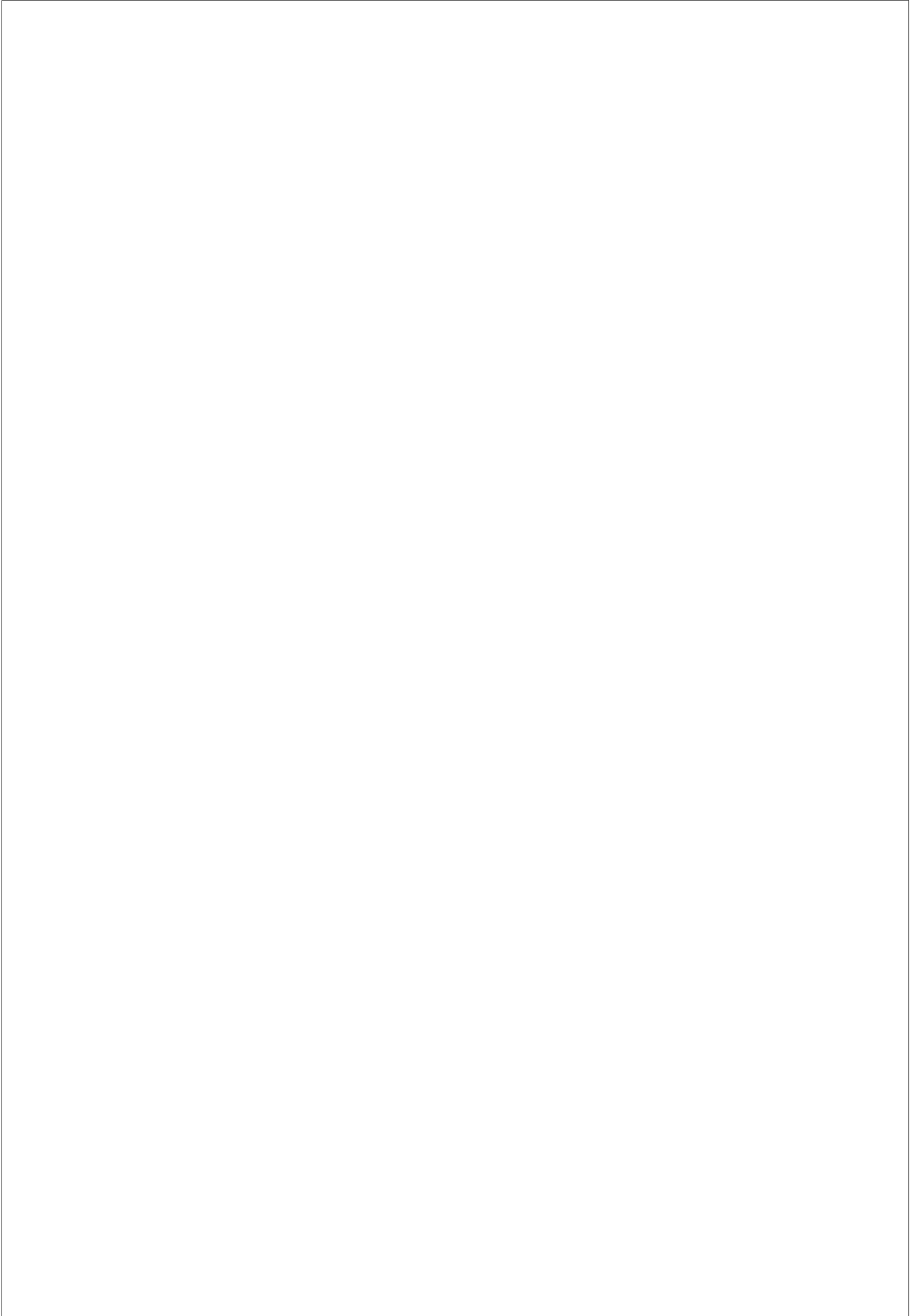
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CENTRAL AMERICA:

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Leaders of the rightist National Conciliation Party, meanwhile, have indicated to US officials that they will continue political attacks against the cogoverning Christian Democrats while avoiding open criticism of Roberto D'Aubuisson's ultraconservative National Republican Alliance. They also implied that they would charge fraud if the Christian Democrats prevail in the election.

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Despite the hard line taken by the National Conciliation Party leaders, some of the more moderate party members previously have indicated that they would consider a postelection alliance with the Christian Democrats. The moderates may suspect complicity by D'Aubuisson in the death of one of their leaders in January. They also probably realize that an ultraconservative government would cost El Salvador important foreign support, which would ultimately benefit the insurgents.

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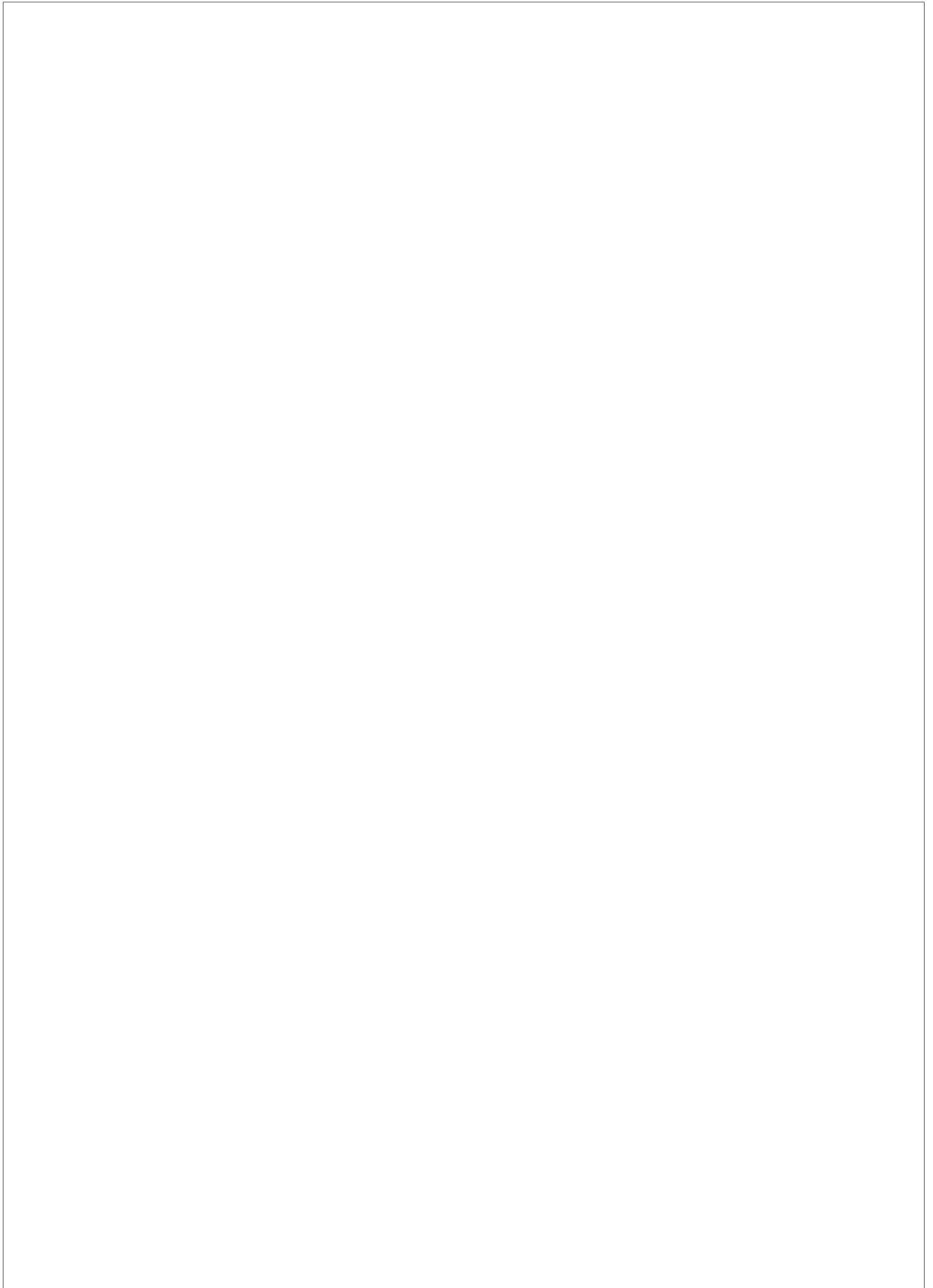
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
