John Mitchell HENSHAW

The most recent information available in our records concerning HENSHAW was received during 1965 in connection with SRS inquiry into another matter. [redacted]

[redacted] advised that HENSHAW was working as a leg-man for Paul SCOTT (of ALLEN-SCOTT). HENSHAW allegedly was able to learn the names of Drew PEARSON's sources by asking Jack ANDERSON, who was totally unaware that HENSHAW then passed these names to Paul SCOTT. HENSHAW, according to this source, was also employed as a leg-man for Jack ANDERSON, but was openly affiliated with the scam-gathering sheet known as the National Enquirer. Another individual associated with HENSHAW, and also known to work for Paul SCOTT, is a Pole name Alex, who does research for both men at the Library of Congress. [redacted] source also provided information in 1964 reflected that HENSHAW was the author of an article in the Enquirer entitled "Washington Insiders are Talking about a Fantastic Story calling Ruby and Oswald Pala" appearing in the 17 May 1964 issue of the paper. Source further stated that SCOTT provided the material and leads for HENSHAW's columns and frequently wrote them for HENSHAW, for which HENSHAW reimbursed SCOTT. HENSHAW was described as a weak man who depended heavily on SCOTT.

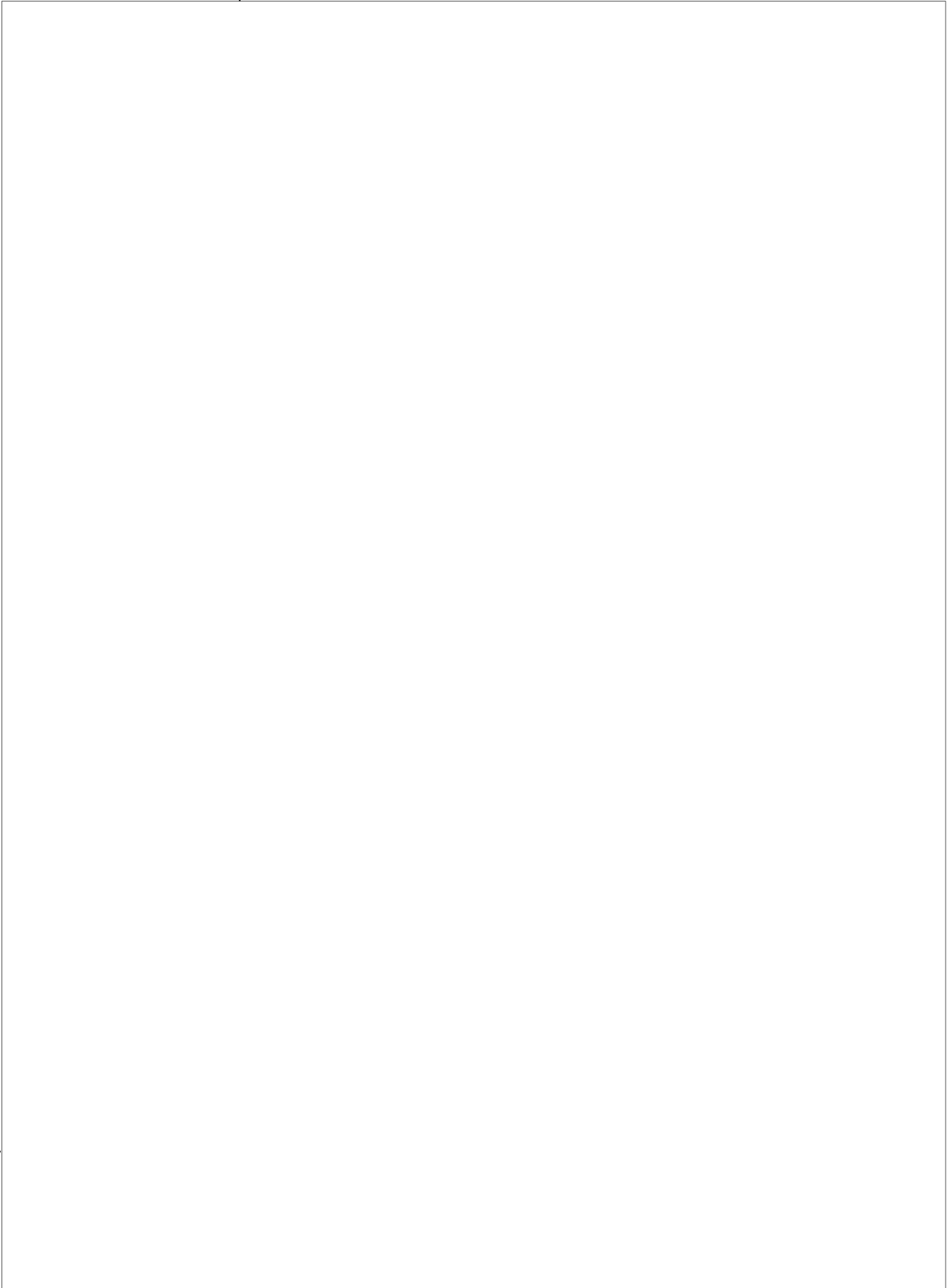

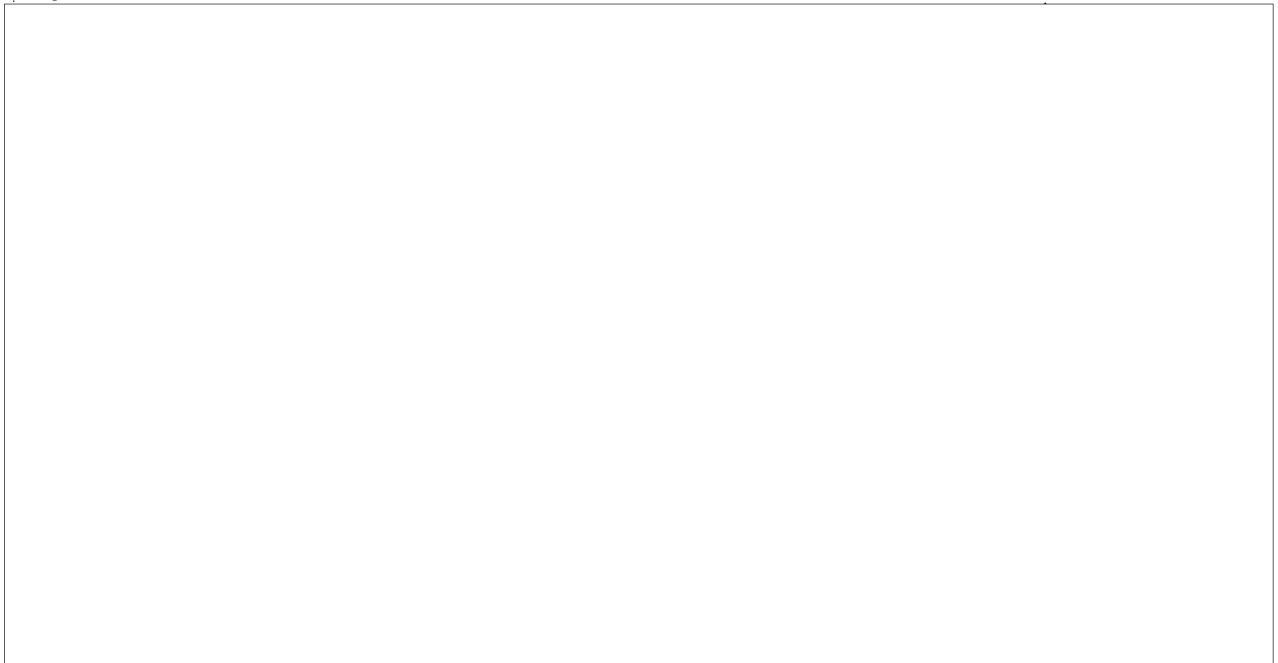
