1. The Director			<p>As you can see from the 25 March response from the Criminal Division, they have made no new concessions on our sources and methods legislative proposal. At least they are now forthright in stating that their concern is with S.1, the proposed revision of the Criminal Code. This is a fairly strong letter, but I believe just about right under the circumstances.</p> <p>I suggest that we send it now in the interest of meeting OMB's request for a 1 April response. Because we did not receive the Justice letter until yesterday afternoon, we had not prepared the remainder of the package. It is essentially a revision of the sectional analysis submitted in January 1974. This can be done fairly quickly next week.</p> <p>George Cary concurs in this letter.</p>
