2. The Commission's treatment of the project contains a great deal more detail than is known to me. It probably reflects the results of reviewing files as well as interviewing individuals. Specific errors of fact and interpretation will obviously be more noticeable to [redacted] than to someone not familiar with the activity. The treatment that may upset him may be as follows:

a. He probably considered the operation to be a matter of foreign counterintelligence, while the Commission emphasizes domestic aspects of it.
