MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT : JMARC Meeting with DDP

PARTICIPANTS: Messrs. Bissell, Barnes, Flannery, Esterline, Reynolds, Eisemann, Drain.

1. The meeting was held to bring JMARC personnel up-to-date on Saturday's special meeting of the Special Group and on the DDP's thinking resulting from that meeting.
2. Mr. Bissell felt that meeting had sufficiently reviewed the outstanding problems to permit the following conclusions:
 - a. We have to be ready to evacuate TRAV of ground trainees, at least temporarily in the case of an as yet unfixed OAS inspection.
 - b. We can plan to use Fort Randolph for up to 200 trainees either for temporary holding or for longer term training.
 - c. We can anticipate the use of a U.S. installation for holding evacuees and possibly also for longer term training.
 - d. There is no objection to continuing air training at MADD nor to the use of Guatemala or Nicaragua for basing air strikes.
 - e. Even if TRAV is evacuated, it could well be continued in use for the training of Guatemalans.
3. There was some discussion as to the cover arrangements which might be arranged for any Z.I. installation chosen for a training area. After reviewing the probable expense of activating a secure area and the likely difficulty of creating a "refugee" cover, the balance of the discussion was concerned with Saipan, about which it was agreed:
 - a. JMARC would promptly ascertain from DDS and OTR what facilities were available and what problems existed in regard to its possible use to train up to 600 men.
 - b. DDP would explore the various facets of air evacuation from TRAV to Saipan, including cost, time, and security. In regard to the latter, it was suggested that JMCLEAR aircraft and crews might evacuate to Del Rio with AF 130's transshipping therefrom.

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4. Concurrently, JMARC would continue to explore the most promising Z.I. sites previously ascertained, and an additional unused Army post on Florida's west coast.

5. The DDP suggested an evacuation date of about 1 December.

Replies to specific points: 1. Ydigoras most enthusiastic collaborator whole program. No doubt in my mind that he considers trainees available. In justification Ydigoras attempted use last week must report that I understand prior "Washington authorization" given to use trainees. I knew nothing regarding their use until half hour prior Secretary's call. Convinced universal public revulsion use Cubans and informed landing already made, I sent message [redacted] urging Ydigoras confine them to military bases and not operate out into civilian areas. Towards end of rebellion, B-26s from Retalhuleu were used by Guatemalan crews. 2. In real desperate situation no doubt in my mind President would look to them for future local purposes. However, facilities Retalhuleu lately used train exclusively Guatemalan commando units. With availability these Guatemalan units, there would be less and less pressure use Cubans. 3. I know of no implied commitments. 4. Since my arrival President has eagerly sought recognition by and identity with US trainee project first time he sought out as an individual. Present training project provided him with ammunition and use B-26s. Project undoubtedly makes Ydigoras feel he has better chance US backing across the board. 5. Anticipate considerable problem with Ydigoras on matter of dispersal, removal, etc. However, less dangerous than those inherent in prolonging stay

Guatemalan units were trained at the several sites so that Cubans could be removed and any congressional, OAS, or international investigators would find only Guatemalans.

Considering nature of an difficulty imposing required discipline on Cubans, I think we have been most fortunate in the way the program has worked out thus far.
