3. Symptoms reported by two observers of the attack included locked jaws, tightening in the chest, and extensive vomiting of blood. Several victims seemed to be bleeding from the skin, especially from the eyes and mouth. The skin felt as if it were burned severely and small blisters formed in 30 minutes to one hour, with death occurring after one to two hours.
