SOURCE

1. UDB Headquarters for Ljubljana is located in the Slavija Bank Building at the corner of Tyrseva and Gajeva Streets. Chief of the interrogation section of UDB, Captain Franc ZALASCEK, who resides at Gajeva Street No. 10, is also chief of the UDB prison in the Narodni Dom Arena. ZALASCEK, who was born at Tolmin, is said to be a ruthless individual and is described as dark complexioned, lean, and six feet tall. Ivan PRIJATELJ and Franc BRNOVSEK, who work with him, are reportedly proven Communists and skilled UDB agents.
2. UDB Headquarters for the suburbs of Ljubljana is located in the Hotel Soca, St. Peter Street No. 4, and is under the direction of Joze RIZMAN. The sections for the various precincts are located throughout the city: one at Meteljko Street No. 3, another in the courtyard of the Provisions Cooperative in Vodnik Square, and a third in Zalokar Street No. 1.
3. A fourth section, located at Cigale Street No. 3, is under the direction of Drago MRVAR who travels often to Trieste and whose wife works in the same office. MRVAR, a former locksmith about 26 years old, was a partisan fighter. He is described as 5'7" tall, quite fat, dark complexioned and has grey hair.
4. The principal Ljubljana courier is one Dusan SEDEJ who reportedly often travels to Trieste. SEDEJ, who lives at Jeglic Street No. 10/1, Ljubljana, has the task of gathering information on border crossers and preparing for their apprehension in conjunction with KNOJ.
5. A building, located in the Narodni Dom Arena garden, now serves as a UDB prison. Under the building the UDB constructed nine bunkers, six of which serve as cells for prisoners and three as torture chambers. The cells are for three persons each and are provided with beds made of cement. The torture chambers are one meter square and are equipped with hooks for tying people to be tortured. One of the most common practices is to fill the bunker with ice or hot water into which the prisoners are placed for hours.
