THE LAWYER FOR AN AUSTRALIAN MAN BEING DETAINED AT A US MILITARY PRISON IN CUBA SAYS HE IS BEING DENIED HIS RIGHTS TO LEGAL REPRESENTATION. SIMON LAUDER REPORTS THE 46-YEAR-OLD SYDNEY MAN IS ACCUSED OF HAVING TRAINED WITH THE TERRORIST NETWORK AL-QA'IDAH. [LAUDER] MAMDOUH HABIB WAS TAKEN INTO US CUSTODY LAST MONTH AND TRANSFERRED TO GUANTANAMO BAY ON THE WEEKEND [4 MAY].
